2 official languages in the city: CATALAN AND SPANISH

Official Language Schools (EOIs, which stands for Escola Oficial d'Idiomes) offer you courses in modern languages, including the local languages of Catalan and Spanish.

You can join **free Catalan courses** in Barcelona through the Consorci per a la Normalització Lingüística (CPNL)



Barcelona in general is a safe city.

EMERGENCIES



is the phone number for medical, rescue, fire-extinguishing or civil defence or police protection emergencies.

24 hours a day and 365 days a year. Calls are free.





What's the NIE?

Identity number for foreign nationals

- It is merely an identification number assigned by Spanish authorities to every foreigner once and for life.
- It is not a Residency Permit. You can apply for a NIE for specific economic, professional or social reasons, even if you do not reside or work in Spain.

 Both EU nationals and non-EU nationals will be assigned a NIE.

Certificate of registration as an EU national

TIE identity card for non-EU foreign nationals



Compulsory for EU individuals wishing to stay in Spain more than 3 months.

Physical identification with no photo. Bring always your National ID.



Visa or permit needed for entering and living.



Compulsory if authorised to stay in Spain for more than 6 months or with a long-term permit.

Physical identification with photo.



Empadronament

Registration in the municipal register of residents



- Every city in Spain has a register of residents (*Padró d'habitants*): a list of people habitually living in it.
- Registering on the list is called *empadronar-se*.
- Key procedure because:
 - Compulsory
 - **Essential** to give you access to certain rights (heath care, schooling...)
 - Needed for many other formalities
- You can complete the formality at any time and in different ways:
 - in person at Citizen Information Office (OAC),
 - online or
 - by telephone (by calling 010).

Individual Health Card

- Free healthcare for holders of the card through the Catalan Health Service (CatSalut).
- Each family member must have his or her own card, regardless of age.
- · necessary in order to:
 - · have a family doctor,
 - go to the health centre or public hospital
 - have access to subsidised medications



If you have a **private medical insurance**, is it necessary?

If you **fall ill** or have an **accident** and have to take **sick leave**, the public healthcare system doctor is the only person authorised to certify it with a **medical certificate**.



Choosing a school

Education in Catalonia and Spain is **compulsory for children aged 6 to 16.**

A child's school year is determined by their year of birth.

Mostly children start when they are 3 years old.

Types of school:

- State schools (escoles públiques)
- Private schools:
 - State-subsidised private schools (escoles concertades)
 - Fully private schools (escoles privades)
