Changes for motorcycles, bicycles, electric scooters and other PMVs

FOR SAFER MOBILITY

The new Byelaw on Pedestrian and Vehicle Traffic fosters safer mobility and mutual respect for everyone travelling in Barcelona's public spaces.

The changes address the following priorities:

- Prioritising pedestrians in the use of pavements as a safe space.
- Regulating the use of personal mobility vehicles (PMVs), such as standard and one-wheel electric scooters, on the public highway.
- Ensuring respect for others when cycling and travelling by scooter, motorcycle, public transport or car.



ELECTRIC SCOOTERS

AND OTHER PERSONAL MOBILITY VEHICLES (PMV



Riding is allowed in bike lanes and on streets with speed limits of 30 km/h or lower.



Carrying passengers is forbidden.

€100 fine



Riding on the pavement is forbidden.

€500 fine



Riding on streets with speed limits of 50 km/h is forbidden.

€500 fine



Helmet obligatory.

€100 fine



Front and back lights obligatory.

€100 fine



Maximum speed.

Fines of up to €500



Speed limit of 10 km/h in bike lanes located on pavements.

Fines of up to €500



Use by people under 16 years of age is forbidden.

€200 fine



Riding with blood alcohol levels above the legal limit, or under the influence of drugs, is forbidden.

€500 fine

BIKES



Riding on the pavement is forbidden, exceptions:

- When riders are under the age of 12 accompanied by adults.
- When riders are under the age of 14 in streets without bike lanes.
- When adult riders carry minors in streets without bike lanes.

BIKES, ELECTRIC SCOOTERS

AND OTHER PERSONAL MOBILITY VEHICLES (PMV



Obligation to get off the vehicle where there are large numbers of pedestrians.

€100 fine



Attaching vehicles to trees, traffic lights, benches, waste containers or any other type of urban furniture is forbidden.

€100 fine

LOADING AND UNLOADING



Motorbikes, bicycles and electric scooters used for goods delivery may use loading and unloading spaces.



Parking in bike lanes for loading or unloading is forbidden for all vehicles.

€200 fine

MOTORCYCLE PARKING



Parking should preferably be on the road.



Parking in spots that block entrances to schools or hospitals is forbidden.

€100 fine



Parking on pavements less than 3 metres wide is forbidden.

€50 fine



Parking by pedestrian crossing kerbs is forbidden €100 fine parking in spots that block access to waste containers is forbidden €50 fine parking in bike lanes is forbidden €100 fine.



Parking in spaces adjacent to bike parking is forbidden.

€100 fine
